GROUNDBREAKING HELD FOR THE BREATHITT COUNTY WATER DISTRICT KENTUCKY 2436 JACKSON WEATHER SERVICE WATER LINE EXTENSION

Jackson, KY – Nesbitt Engineering, Inc. participated in a groundbreaking for the project to extend water lines to the Jackson Weather Service. The ground breaking was held on August 8th, 2017 at the Julian Carroll Airport in Jackson, KY.

The project was established to provide running water to the Jackson Weather Service location for the first time since it was established nearly 40 years ago. Funding for the project came from a joint venture supported by the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) and the Jackson Weather Service. The ARC awarded \$215,000 for the project and the Jackson Weather Service invested \$75,000 alongside the Breathitt County Fiscal Court. The water extension project is expected to be finished by the end of 2018.

Joining President, Paul D. Nesbitt from Nesbitt Engineering, Inc. was Congressman Hal Rogers, Sandy Dunahoo, Commissioner of the Kentucky Department for Local Government; State Rep. Toby Herald; Shawn Harley, Meteorologist-in-charge; J.L. Smith, Breathitt County Judge Executive and Rose Wolfe, Mayor of Jackson.
